**INSTRUCTION and SUGGESTIONS**

1.—Parties calling central must give their own name, and tell where they are speaking from; also when a particular person is desired give their name as well as number.

2.—Give number as follows: For 1522 say fifteen two two, or for 1003 say ten nought three.

3.—Complaints regarding service should be made direct to the Manager.

4.—Don't expect too much of the operators. Have patience. Remember they have several score others to wait on as well as you.

## Read the Following Directions and Regulations Carefully

Remove receiver, say hello, and listen. If line is busy, replace receiver at once, wait until parties speaking ring off. If calling central—Press button on side of telephone and give one quick turn of crank, again take down receiver and listen. When operator answers, give number desired, your own name and particular person wanted. When conversation is completed, replace receiver, and give one quick, short turn of crank.

A telephone holder, shall be charged for messages sent for or by non-subscribers or any person not belonging to their household, excepting by their employees or the employers of the above named Company, or its phoneholders. Never listen to a conversation, not intended for you, or answer any signal but your own. Repetition of what you hear, is against the rules, a breach of trust, and a violation of the law.

If line is required by another subscriber, no conversation shall continue for more than five minutes. Common conversation shall not be permitted when the line is required for business messages. Never call a subscriber to the telephone for a social chat during business hours. Don't waste the time of other people talking longer than necessary. Don't visit with the operator. This is an imposition on other subscribers. Never relate gossip over the wire. The telephone is only to be used when you have something to say. Abusive and profane language is strictly forbidden. Answer your calls promptly by one short ring. Don't wait for latter signal, when calling central. Attach no electrical or other contrivance to the line or telephone. Don't give concerts over the line, or induce subscribers to remove their receivers from the hook, for more than five minutes at any one time. Remember the success of party lines lies largely in the hands of the subscribers, their having patience and not annoying one another in any way.

Messenger service will be charged at any switch to both telephone holder and non-subscriber. Collect messenger service and tole rate immediately after conversation and at once enter on tole account books or tickets. Both sending and receiving stations book.
